Wearing the school uniform

It is an expectation of the school, that all students be in complete and correct uniform and present themselves in a clean, tidy and well-groomed manner. This expectation extends beyond the school grounds, as the representation of St Thomas More in the community is influenced by students wearing the full and correct uniform. It is expected that students come to and from school in the correct uniform. The STM Uniform:

- fosters a sense of school community and shared mission
- increases a sense of belonging and engagement
- promotes health and safety
- encourages respect in self and school.

Teachers will remind students of what is required should they not meet expectations. It is important that in the first instance, parents check daily that the uniform and personal appearance standards are being met. This partnership between home and STM is important. This includes attention to the maintenance of uniforms in terms of wear and tear, freshness and size. The correct uniform is to be worn everyday any exceptions from the uniform are to be explained in writing to the classroom teacher.

Our sun safety policy requires the wearing of hats whenever outdoors. Therefore, the wearing of hats with both the formal and sports uniform plays a significant part in keeping the students safe at STM.



STM Uniform Expectations

Hair

- Kept neat, tidy and off the face at all times
- Tracks, line art or coloured extensions not permitted
- Must be tied back if collar-length or longer.
- Hair ties, headbands, scrunchies and ribbons are to be red, navy or white.

Make-up

- Make-up or beauty accessories are not permitted. This includes mascara, nail polish, false/acrylic nails or false eyelashes.

Jewellery

- Students may wear limited and simple jewellery restricted to the following:
- One pair of small plain earrings (sleepers or studs)
- A small, discreet religious symbol can be worn under uniform
- A simple watch (smart watches must be in school mode)
- Due to safety other additional jewelry is not permitted

Mobile Phones

- Student mobile phones must be signed into student reception at the start of the school day
- Student mobile phones are not to be used during school hours.

Socks

- Plain white/navy socks or STM uniform socks only (logo socks not permitted)

Chewing Gum

Chewing gum is not permitted at school at any time
